<p><b>We encourage you to buy 2 P.E shirts if your child is in years 4-6 as they partake in sports on a daily basis and long sleeve beige polo shirt for winter.</b></p>	

## **Jewellery**

For safety reasons students may wear:

- Plain gold or silver studs, (not hoops)
- A watch
- No other jewellery including facial or body piercing is permitted

## **Hair**

Natural colours and moderate styles that do not cover a student's eyes. Black hair ties and black headbands are permitted for girls.

**We expect that students respect and abide by school values and expectations when wearing their school uniform.**

- Only approved school uniform items will be visible. Non-regulation items will not be permitted
- Nail polish is not permitted
- Students arriving in incorrect uniform to school will have a note of explanation from their parent/caregiver
- The school's high expectations of uniform standards are to be maintained at all times by students as a matter of school pride and protocol.
