

Our logo is derived from the shapes created when three circles intersect in a Venn-type diagram. These elements embody the vision and values of our new and constantly evolving learning community at Mission Heights Primary School. The shape of our logo depicts life long learning as continuous and ongoing through out life, and it's different stages and authentic contexts.

Each space in our logo represents the main aspects of our school that make up our whole school community:

- Staff;
- Students and
- Parents.

The centre of the logo represents the heart of our school community – the learners – be they students, teachers or parents learning and growing together.

In providing a balanced education that enables the academic, physical, social and leadership development of our students, our logo represents three essentials of Mission Heights Primary School's curriculum:

- core literacy skills;
- global literacy skills; and
- digital literacy skills.

The **Koru** in our logo represents our New Zealand heritage symbolising new beginnings, growth and new learning as well as our desire to foster responsible stewardship for our natural resources and environment, within a culture of care.

Finally, the dark outer lines around our logo reflect the ongoing connectedness of our students to life long learning and to the world beyond school as they engage with their local, national, and wider global community as life long learners.
